## GENERAL INFORMATION

The CAS-TWAS President's Fellowship Programme is a joint initiative of the Chinese Academy of Sciences (CAS) and The World Academy of Sciences (TWAS) for the advancement of science in developing countries. It provides opportunities to students from countries other than China to pursuit Ph.D. degrees in CAS for a maximum of 4 vears.

CAS's education is provided by both its 2 universities and over 100 institutes located across the country. It particularly emphasizes on combining teaching and research. The 2 universities are to confer degrees to graduates upon their completion of general courses and research in the schools/institutes.

Awardees will receive a monthly allowance including accommodation cost and other living expenses, local travel expenses & health insurance of RMB 7,000 or RMB 8,000 as well as tuition waivers from CAS

#### Requirements

- Non Chinese citizenship
- Under the age of 35
- No other assignments during the period of his/her fellowship
- Meet the admission criteria for international students of UCAS/USTC (http://english.ucas.ac.cn/Admissions/ Pages/Article.aspx?ID=78 or http://en.ustc.edu.cn/admissions/international students/)
- A master degree before the beginning of the study
- Proficiency either in English or Chinese Note: Any applicant currently pursuing Ph.D. degree at any university/institute in China is not eligible for this fellowship. Applicants can not apply for both UCAS and USTC simultaneously
